A discharge form will be sent to you on receipt of written confirmation that the offer is accepted. This discharge form will be invalidated in the event of any alterations and/or amendments being affected thereto after date of issue by the RAF.

If this offer of settlement contains an offer of a contribution in respect of party and party costs, and you would prefer to submit a bill of costs, kindly indicate this in your letter of acceptance to enable the RAF to correctly complete the discharge form.

In the event of either the capital or costs offered exceeding R29 000.00, this offer is conditional on the claimant accepting structured payment of the capital and/or costs.

A. CAPITAL

This offer is conditional on the claimant accepting structured payment of the capital amount of R42 277.55 in 2 installments, the first installment of R21 138.77 will be paid on the 28th day of the month following receipt of the discharge form signed by the claimant and subsequent equal installment(s) of R21 138.78 each will be paid on the 28th day of each successive month.

B. COSTS

- i) In the event of the claimant accepting the cost contribution offered, payment of the cost contribution in the sum of R3 000.00 will be made on the 28th of the month following receipt of the discharge form signed by the claimant.
- ii) In the event of the claimant submitting a bill of cost, payment of the taxed or agreed party and party costs less than R25 000.00 will be paid on the 28th day of the month following the settlement of the costs, alternatively the taxation of the bill.

The RAF will not be liable to pay any interest on the capital and/or cost amounts by reason of the payment in installments.

This offer remains open for acceptance by the claimant for a period of two months from the date of its' issue and if not accepted within that period, will automatically lapse and will only be reinstated at the sols election of the RAE. However in the event of a claim-becoming-prescribed within the aforesaid two month period, the offer will only remain open for acceptance until the day preceding the date on which the claim becomes prescribed.

If this offer is purportedly accepted on the strength of the power of attorney given by a claimant who has died prior to such purported acceptance, a valid settlement agreement will not come into existence, and any payment erroneously made by RAF in terms of such putative settlement agreement will be fully refundable to the RAF by the person or firm who so purported to accept this offer or
